Parent Education Activity Information Hub

Summary

This circular memorandum informs schools that a new feature “Parent Education Activity Information Hub” (Activity Information Hub) is set up on the parent education website “Smart Parent Net” established by the Education Bureau (EDB) to provide parents of kindergartens as well as primary and secondary schools with a one-stop access to information on parent education courses/activities so as to further enhance their knowledge and skills in parenting.

Background

2. The EDB attaches great importance to parent education. A parent education website “Smart Parent Net” was launched in February 2018 to provide information on parent education which enables parents to easily access useful information on supporting the physical and psychological development of students, including parent-child relationship, character development, parenting skills and emotional management of parents, etc. Through the continued enrichment of the contents therein, the “Smart Parent Net” has become an invaluable source of information for parents.



Details

3. To further promote parent education, a new feature, i.e. Activity Information Hub, is launched on the “Smart Parent Net”. It provides various kinds of information on parent education courses/activities organised by different Government bureaux and departments as well as post-secondary institutions in Hong Kong. The content will also be updated regularly to let parents keep up with the latest information.

4. In the Activity Information Hub, parents can filter activity information by using the category function, such as district, activity type, target participants, organiser, etc., which facilitate them to select suitable courses/activities. The Activity Information Hub will also

provide application links of the courses/activities so that parents can obtain further application details quickly.

5. Schools are encouraged to recommend the “Smart Parent Net” and the newly launched Activity Information Hub to their parents, and add related hyperlinks and QR codes to the school websites so that parents can easily access to the latest parent education information.
